
PRISMA 2020 flow diagram for new systematic reviews which included searches of databases and registers only

- WD, Wrong design: cross-sectional and descriptive or comparative
- WO, Wrong outcome: do not include BC outcomes, or do not include sport practice specific outcome.
- WP, Wrong population: children, injured athletes, not athletes, disabled athletes, animals.
- WPT, Wrong publication type: consensus statements and similar
- D, Duplicate
